Communications upgrade Lebanon's telecom authority receives \$3 million USAID grant



BEIRUT: The US Agency for International Development (USAID) on Friday provided a \$3 million grant to Lebanon's Telecom Regulatory Authority (TRA) to buy advanced-spectrum measurement and management system. The agreement was signed by the chairman of TRA Ka-

mal Shehadi, Denise Herbol, USAID mission director and in the presence of US Ambassador to Lebanon Michele Sison. The new system will prevent intervention in the systems and allow the companies to use their wavelength only. — The Daily Star
